

TEE OFF FOR TEDDY

BALDIVIS LIONS CLUB is holding a fundraising **GOLF DAY** at Secret Harbour Golf Course on **SUNDAY 6th DECEMBER 2020**. This is the second annual Golf Day we have held. The purpose of the Day is to raise funds for treatment for delightful nine year old Theodore (Teddy) Legg who was born with a rare chromosome abnormality, so rare it does not have a name. Theodore's mother Sharon said the disruption to his chromosomal makeup affected almost every organ in his body and hence his development.



Teddy and his parents, Sharon and Andrew Legg first came into the lives of our Club some four years ago and we feel very privileged to have been able to hold several fundraising events to enable Teddy and his parents to travel to Adelaide on three occasions, so Teddy could undergo specialist Cuevas Medek exercises by Chad Timmerman at Timmermans Clinic in that city. The therapy elicits improvements in posture, balance and motor control. It is intense and expensive but has given Teddy freedom of movement. When we first met Teddy, he was virtually unable to move from the floor and he had never crawled. However, after three visits to the Timmermans Clinic and ongoing exercises carried out at home, we have witnessed a miracle. Teddy can now walk between chairs and other short distances.
